Re: Support to Manitoba Keewatinowi Okimakanak with regard to Adaptive Phased Management 2015-2016 – To promote education and awareness and to foster positive dialogue in MKO communities

Dear Grand Chief Harper:

Thank you for your interest in continuing the positive relationship between Manitoba Keewatinowi Okimakanak (MKO) and NWMO in support of the 30 First Nations in MKO Manitoba Territory in understanding the long-term management of used nuclear fuel in Canada through the Adaptive Phased Management Site Selection Process.

With this letter, we are pleased to confirm our agreement with the request for support as outlined in the work plan originally submitted to NWMO on January 14th, 2015, resubmitted on January 23rd, 2015 and letter of addendum submitted on February 5th, 2015 (the "Work Plan").

NWMO will provide funds up to \$312,689 for the MKO 2015-2016 Work Plan. The agreement period is March 1, 2015 to February 29, 2016 and the work plan budget in broad terms is summarized as follows:

NWMO is advancing 30% of the funds to the MKO at this time (\$94,000).

Remaining agreement funds can be paid in two installments of 30% each by request (an invoice) and the submission of an accounting of the use of previously advanced funds up to that time. At the completion of the agreement, the final 10% will be reimbursed with final accounting of the use of funds.

The agreement requires an accounting of the use of these funds at least every six months during this program.

NWMO will require a summary report of all activities and meetings undertaken.

This agreement stipulates a full-time project manager position. The NWMO is firm in the requirement that the position remains exclusive to the NWMO project and that the work of the project manager includes all aspects of planning, coordination, liaison activities and non-financial reporting.

Financial reporting:

At the request for an advance, or at six months, NWMO requires a financial report describing how funds have been spent under this agreement, including the following documentation:

- A statement of expenditures identifying the use of NWMO-provided funds by type of cost accompanied by an extract of the General Ledger or a list of expenditures printed from the accounting system, which shows the use of NWMO funding; and
- The NWMO may request further explanation or supporting receipts if needed.

If you have any question or concerns about this financial reporting, please contact the NWMO representative named at the end of this letter. We would be pleased to assist you to ensure you are able to meet the terms of these requirements.

Year-End Summary of Activities Report:

An interim activity report is due July 31, 2015 and a Year-end report summarizing all activities under the Agreement is to be submitted by February 29, 2016.

Progress Reporting

Every six months, the MKO and NWMO will jointly review progress on activities funded by this agreement.

MKO agrees that it will use these funds exclusively for expenses related to the Adaptive Phased Management Site Selection process as set out above in this agreement and will return excess or improperly used funds, if any, to the NWMO upon request.
